These offices provide a broad range of intelligence and business development services for both Austrian companies and their international business partners.

Furthermore all Aussenwirtschaft Austria offices were informed about the launch of the OECD database on specific instances.

In 2013 the Austrian Federal Ministry for Europe. Integration and Foreign Affairs, yet another member of the NCP's Steering Committee, also sent the same promotion letter to the Austrian embassies and selected consulates.

D. Co-operation and peer learning

In addition to contributing to the Committee's work to enhance the effectiveness of the Guidelines, NCPs will engage in joint peer learning activities. In particular, they are encouraged to engage in horizontal, thematic peer reviews and voluntary NCP peer evaluations. Such peer learning can be carried out through meetings at the OECD or through direct co-operation between NCPs.
